School Policy on Bullying

At Boyanup Primary School, we are committed to ensuring a safe and supportive environment where all members of our school community have the right to be respected and have the responsibility to respect each other. We aim to provide an environment that is physically, emotionally and intellectually safe for all members of our school community.

We seek to achieve this by;

- Preventing the occurrence of bullying by educating students on establishing positive relationships and reinforcing the rights and responsibilities of all school members.
- Developing individual self-esteem and respect for others through targeted lessons and activities from our whole school Social Emotional and Well Being programs '**You Can Do It! Education**', '**Zones of Regulation**' and '**MindUp**'.
- A whole school approach to behaviour management through the implementation of the SWPBIS (School Wide Positive Behaviour Intervention Support) framework. Abbreviated to PBS, is a framework or approach for enhancing the adoption and implementation of a continuum of evidence based interventions to achieve academically and behaviourally important outcomes for all students. PBS is strongly supported by the Department of Education and is commonly practiced amongst many schools throughout the south west.
- Addressing bullying by processes of reconciliation, teaching of expected behaviours, support (which may involve external agencies and school psychological and chaplaincy services) or sanctions which are directly linked with the Education of Department Policy.
